



TRAFFIC IMPACTS

2015 Larry H. Miller Tour of Utah
Stage 5 presented by Utah Sports Commission - Friday, Aug. 7
Salt Lake City Downtown Circuit
Race Time 4:40 to 6:45 p.m.



Listed here are probable impact areas and timelines for motorists, home owners and businesses who will be using the same roadways as the Tour of Utah on Friday, Aug. 7.

Traffic will be restricted and parking will NOT be allowed on the following roads during the race:

- E 500 N at the Utah State Capitol Complex
- Eastbound East 11th Ave. between B Street and Virginia Street
- Virginia Street / University Street from E. 11th Avenue to 100 South
- 100 South to 1300 East
- 1300 East from 100 South to South Temple
- South Temple from Virginia Street to State Street
- 200 West from North Temple to 600 North
- Wall Street from 600 North to Zane Avenue
- West Capitol from Zane Avenue to 500 North



Additional information:

- The race will start at 4:40 p.m. on E 500 North.
- The race will finish between 6:45-7 p.m.
- Total distance of the race is 55 miles, making seven laps of an eight-mile circuit.
- Each lap is expected to take approximately 18-22 minutes to complete.
- Police will begin closing the roads to traffic at approximately 4:15 p.m.
- Traffic will be allowed to cross the course during the race under police control. There may be a short delay as the race passes.
- There will be traffic delays, but no part of the area will lack access. Emergency vehicles will not be affected by road closures.
- On race day, residents and merchants who live or do business near the course should contact a police officer posted near their street so they can be assisted in accessing or leaving their home or business. Every effort will be made to accommodate residents and merchants.
- Reservoir Park will host the Tour of Utah Lifestyle Expo from 4 to 7 p.m. The race will pass three sides of the park each lap. The Expo will offer vendor displays, concessions and a big screen TV to watch all the race action.
- Visit team parking and Autography Alley to get photos and signatures from athletes. This will be available from 3:30-4:40 p.m. at the start/finish line, located at 50 E 500 N.
- Pedestrians are welcome to walk the course. However, we request that you stay on the sidewalks, and do not impede the movement of local residents, police and course marshals who will be using the respites between circuits to move people in and out of the neighborhoods.
- Spectators are encouraged to use a GREENbike to reach the course. You can park it at Harmon's Grocery store at State Street and 1st South, one block from Eagle Gate, to see the race.
- Use Utah Transit Authority's TRAX Blue Line or Green Line for easy access to course from the City Center stop (100 S. Main Street). A one-way ticket is \$2.50; Day Pass is \$6.25; Group Pass for four people is \$10 roundtrip. For detail, visit www.rideuta.com.
