Herbert, we write to give you notice that on Monday, December 4, 2017, the President of the United States of America will travel to the Utah State Capitol. Having just received formal confirmation of this visit from the White House, we wanted to provide you ample notice to plan your travel and/or commute accordingly.

This visit will require significant, expedited action and accommodation, which may take the form of road closures, security measures, and much more. We wanted to be as proactive as possible when informing you of the possible transportation limitations, restrictions, and delays. Additionally, the nature of this visit may result in large numbers of people crowding the area surrounding the Capitol Hill Complex.
