PROJECT UPDATE - SEPTEMBER 11, 2015

ONGOING CONSTRUCTION ACTIVTIES

- Crews will continue upgrading pedestrian ramps, lowering utility manholes and replacing some curb and gutter on the streets surrounding the Capitol.
- Parking restrictions on the streets surrounding the Capitol will be necessary during construction. Please adhere to all "No Parking" signage and indicators.
- Columbus Street; Zane Avenue to 500 North will remain closed through September 21. Crews are currently replacing curb, gutter and sidewalk and working on utilities.
- State Street; 300 North to North Temple will remain closed through September 13. Crews will remove and replace the asphalt on September 12 and 13.

UPCOMING ROAD CLOSURES

• 300 North; East Capitol to Columbus Street will be closed September 12 – 13 while crews remove asphalt. Local traffic, please use detour on Main Street and North Temple.

PROJECT INFORMATION

Crews will work during daytime hours on Capitol Hill, with some night time paving on Victory Road possible. Additional notice will be provided should that occur. Some construction activities will require road closures and weekend work. Local access to residents will be maintained. Commuter traffic traveling through the area is encouraged to detour around construction on Beck street / 300 West and North Temple.

PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Utah Department of Transportation (UDOT) is working to upgrade Victory Road from Beck Street to North Temple along with the streets surrounding the Capitol. The project will include new asphalt, increased parking near the Capitol, upgraded pedestrian ramps and a traffic signal at the intersection of Victory Road and 500 North.
